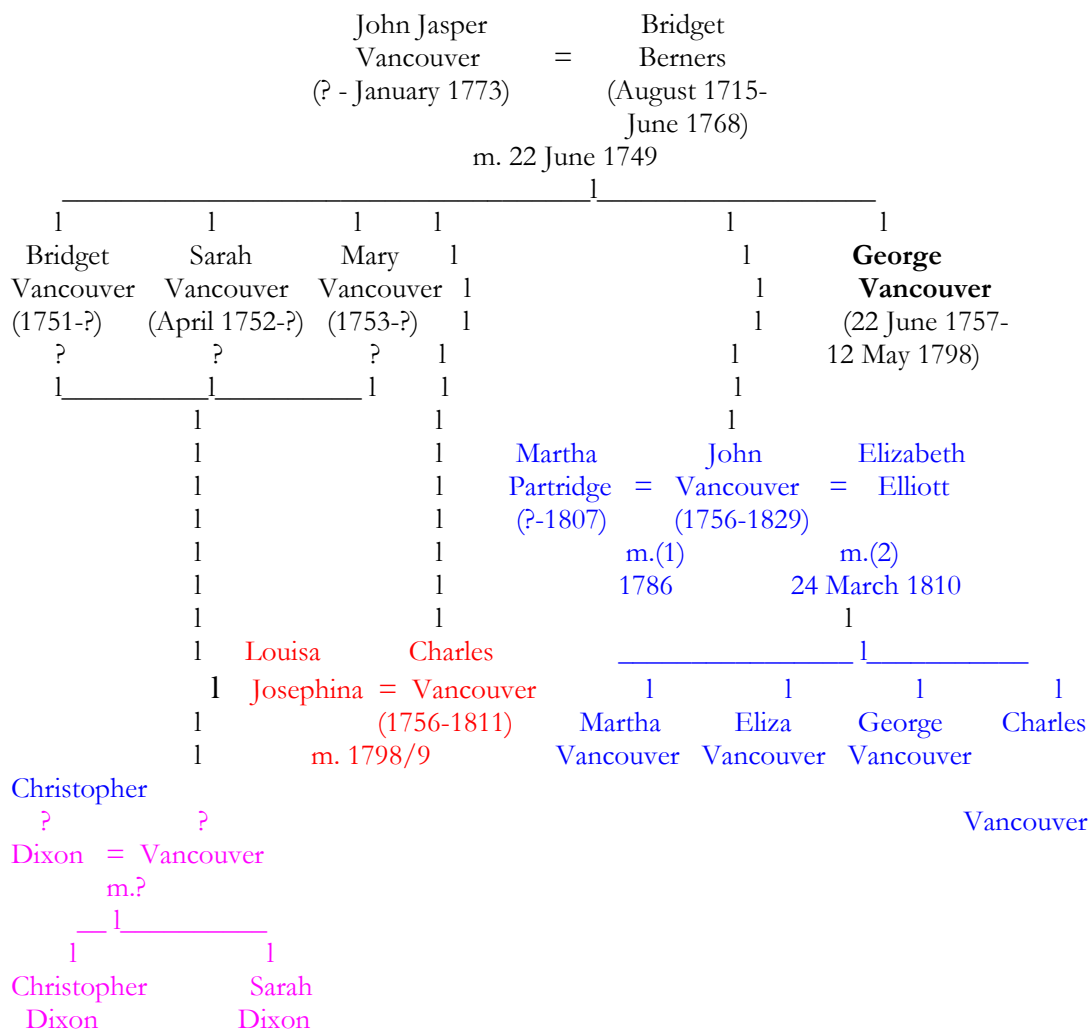


A family tree of George Vancouver's immediate family.



At this time (18 February 2005) I do not know which of the Vancouver sisters married Mr Dixon to produce the nephew and niece mentioned by Charles Vancouver in his will. I do not know if all of the sisters married. No wills are listed at the FRC of National Archives for any other Vancouvers.

George Vancouver died in 1798. In his will, he mentions Sarah, Mary, Charles and John, which suggests that Bridget was already dead.

Charles Vancouver, in his will (dated 1811), mentions his wife Louisa and his nephew Christopher Dixon and a niece Sarah Dixon.

John Vancouver, in his will (dated 1829), mentions his wife Elizabeth and their four children.

Charles appears to have had no children. George never married and had no children. The surname Vancouver, which had just made an appearance, seems to have died out very quickly so it is most probable that neither of the two sons of John Vancouver had male children.
